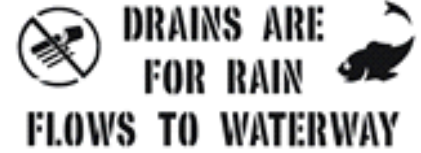




# Storm Drain Marking Registration 2017



Join PCS for Global Youth Service Day on **Saturday, April 22nd from 9:00am-12:00pm**. The deadline to register is **April 12th**. An optional Global Youth Service Day Appreciation Picnic will be held on the United Way of Greater Toledo lawn at 12:30pm, after the program is completed.

Marking storm drains reminds residents that these drains flow directly to waterways, without treatment. It also reminds residents that storm drains are not trash bins. Our volunteers spray paint over a stencil near several storm drains and deliver informational door hangers to houses in nearby areas. All equipment and training is provided. This program is recommended for children above the age of 10; however, younger children are encouraged to participate with increased direct supervision.

We assign groups to jurisdictions depending on preference, jurisdiction needs, size of groups, number of drains to stencil, and ages of participants. Because the activity is restricted by wet pavement or very cold conditions, the event may need to be postponed due to weather. The rain out date for Storm Drain Marking, independent of Global Youth Service Day, is **April 29<sup>th</sup>**. It is up to you to make up the event if canceled due to weather. Even if weather does not permit marking drains that day, groups might be asked to clean trash from around a parking lot, park, or nearby school to prevent trash from entering the river via storm drains.
